A new kind of camper

The Dashaway ECTS is a compact, single-berth towable camper with an elevating roof, a fully equipped kitchen and toilet facilities. A generous sofa converts into a wide single bed in seconds. Think of it as a Wheelhome campervan that you tow — with petrol, diesel, hybrid or electric cars. Its lightweight 425 kg (including the standard-fit Motor Mover) means it can be easily handled by one person.

Fully Self-Supporting

No pegging out required — fully functional on hard standings and even overnight layby stops. Its footprint stays the same unless you add the optional awning.

Five-Minute Setup

Lower the two rear steadies and turn the handle to raise the elevating roof — gas struts do the heavy lifting. Full standing headroom and campervan comfort.
